Apparently, while the railroad was under construction and before the area was named, someone from Salt Lake City asked a telegrapher where she was. While trying to think of an answer, she notice "Lynn Mass" printed on her shoe, so she answered "at Lynn" – so the junction now has a name. However, when an application was filed at the post office, a Lynn already existed in Box Elder County so "dyl" was added.
