



BECOME A WEATHER PATRIOT! VOLUNTEER WEATHER OBSERVER NEEDED IN FILLMORE

The Salt Lake City National Weather Service is currently trying to relocate the official Cooperative Observer weather station in Fillmore. Our first step is to find a volunteer to accept the responsibility of taking daily weather observations (max/min temperatures, rainfall, snowfall and snow depth) and reporting them to the National Weather Service.

Observer requirements are as follows:

1. The weather station needs to be located within the pictured area of Fillmore (left) in a secure area, i.e. a residential back yard or a fenced in area that provides safety for the equipment (pictured at bottom).
2. If the station is to be located on private property, the owner should be or will be a long-term resident.
3. The individual who will be in charge of the station will be required to manually log observations at the same time in the AM/PM, then input the data into a secure website or onto a spreadsheet to be mailed.

The NWS will provide the equipment and the training on how to use it.
